Thank you for your interest in joining the NYC Amateur Radio Emergency Communications Service.

These are our guidelines for membership:

NYC-ARECS is a member-run, independent organization dedicated to providing event and emergency communication for the citizens of New York City, primarily through the use of amateur radio. There are no dues or fees for membership in NYC-ARECS. Details are on our website (http://www.nyc-arecs.org)

NYC-ARECS membership is granted by request, and maintained with participation (see below) There are four categories of membership in NYC-ARECS. Individuals without FCC-issued amateur radio licenses can be Auxiliary members, while those with amateur radio licenses can be New, Active, or Inactive members. All members may participate in NYC-ARECS activities, but only Active members may vote in NYC-ARECS elections or hold positions as officers.

NYC-ARECS members and officers are encouraged to hold memberships in other emergency communications organizations, but are not required to do so. NYC-ARECS is not affiliated with the American Radio Relay League or the Amateur Radio Emergency Service. We support the activities of the Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service as outlined in FCC Part97.

Maintaining Active (voting) membership after the first year requires the following:

- * Checking into at least **50%** of the NYC-ARECS nets, held Monday evenings at 8:30PM local time on 441.100 (PL 136.5) [alternate 145.230 (PL 114.8) / 447.625 (PL 136.5)] of the N2ROW system.
- * Providing auxiliary communications during at least **four** public service events (walk-a-thons, races, bike tours, etc.) per year, from the list of events maintained by the NYC-ARECS president.
- * Completing training courses as outlined in the NYC-ARECS Constitution and By-Laws (http://www.nyc-arecs.org/constitution.htm).
- * Attend **monthly** meetings (if held, from January through November).

 The annual citywide general meeting is held every December, where all voting occurs.
